- All rights to the content received will belong to the Office of the Commissioner for Children.
- Some entries will be used in material published by the Office.

The top 3 entries from each category will be invited to the Office of the Commissioner for Children and will be given a prize. The top 10 entries from each category will be given a certificate to acknowledge their work.

The winners will be announced by the end of March 2024.
